The Public Education Officer of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Ogun, Mrs Florence Okpe, who confirmed the incident to newsmen in Abeokuta said, "The accident occurred around 11:55 a.m. and the suspected cause of the crash was excessive speed and loss of control which made the vehicle to plumpe into the river.

The vehicle marked APP 830 HX was coming from Benin and heading to Lagos," she added.

Okpe added that three male adults were found dead while one person sustained injuries in the lone vehicle accident.

The FRSC spokesperson explained that the injured victim was taken to Hope Clinic J4 in the Ijebu-East Local Government Area of the state.

"Bodies of those dead were deposited at the State General Hospital morgue in Ijebu-Ode," she said.

Police neutralise scores of kidnappers, rescue 16 victims in Bauchi

The Bauchi State Police Command has burst suspected kidnappers' enclaves, neutralised scores and injured several others in Burra Forest, Ningi Local Government Area of the state.

In a press release issued by the Command's PPRO, Ahmed Wakil, he said 16 kidnap victims were rescued, out of which five sustained various degrees of injuries while the remaining 11 were rescued un-

Wakil said, "On 02/9/2023 at about

1500hrs, police operatives in line with Operation Restore Peace (ORP) comprising police, military and other quasi-security outfits, particularly local hunters on a routine patrol stormed the kidnappers' den located on top of the mountain, situated at Shande village area of Kurmi, a village at the outskirts of Burra. On sighting the team of combined operatives, the kidnappers started firing at the operatives.

"However, in response, the operatives repelled the kidnappers with superior fire-power which lasted for about 2 hours. As a result, 16 kidnap victims were rescued, out of which five kidnap victims sustained

various degrees of injuries while the remaining 11 were rescued unhurt.

"The following are the injured rescued victims: Alh. Shuaibu 'm' of Kurmi village Burra, Alh. Bammi 'm' of Kongoro village Burra, Mai Unguwa Shende village Burra, Dantsoho Mai Shayi 'm' of Kurmi village Burra, Abubakar 'm' of Matigwai village Sumaila LGA Kano State.

"They were evacuated to Burra General Hospital for immediate medical treatment. The remaining 11 victims rescued unhurt are: Zahariya Ibrahim age 17yrs f' of Dana Village Burra, Walida Idi age
