

It was also learnt that four people in Nagi Camp in Mbachohon council ward of Gwer West Local Government Area may have equally been killed. Those said to be missing include Joe Igba, Nyali Akula, Tarvihi Donald and Tyozenda.

Meanwhile, Governor Alia has utterly condemned both unprovoked attacks 'by suspected armed herders'. He "frowned and maimed and kill innocent Benue citizens in cold blood for reasons which are difficult to grasp and pin down."

He maintained that Benue is an agrarian society whose economy is largely based on producing and maintaining crops and is being killed daily on their farmlands and their villages for a cause very unknown to us."

The Governor, in a statement by his Chief Press Secretary, Mr. Tersoo Kula, who lamented cases of alleged herdsmen attacking lives and property said he will not rest until such barbaric acts are curtailed.
