The Anambra State Police Command has killed three of the armed gang members suspected to have attacked the convoy of a Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) chieftain, Chief Chris Uba.

During the attack by the gunmen, on 28th December, two police personnel of Enugu State Command were killed at Uga, in Aguata Local Government Area of Anambra State.

the state, Aderemi Adeoye, who confirmed this in an interview with reporters, said a 51-year-old kidnap victim was rescued during the operation.

He assured the public that intensive manhunt for the remnants of the gang was ongoing,

reiterating that there would be no hiding place for criminals in the state.

He said: "Since the attack at Uga, the gang had been under close surveillance. But what held the police back was to avoid unintended casualties of the

season's merry makers.

"The police struck immediately the gang was isolated from the innocent public somewhere around Ogboji, in Orumba South Local Government Area.

"Three members of the gang were killed, four Improvised

Explosive Devices (IEDs) were recovered and defused.

"In addition to that, two pump action guns and 16 live cartridges were recovered as well as one Lexus SUV.

"A 51-year old kidnap victim was rescued."
