

...as hoodlums murder 27-year-old man in Ogun

A 27 year old man, Toriola Tobi, has been reportedly murdered by some suspected hoodlums in Abeo-

kuta, Ogun State.

The victim, according to the police was murdered on Monday at about 7pm while walking alone along a secluded street in Isokan Estate behind Premier Grammar School area.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Omolola Odutola, who confirmed the incident to journalists in Abeokuta yesterday, said the identity and details of the hoodlums who attacked and killed Toriola is not yet known.

She said the victim had engaged in scuffle with some individuals who later escaped from the scene.

"Victim was injured after a scuffle with the unidentified individuals who then escaped the scene. His remains have been deposited at the morgue, for autopsy.

"An investigation has commenced, and the Commissioner of Police, CP Alamutu Abiodun Mustapha, has directed every intelligence to be deployed to ensure the fleeing suspects are apprehended.

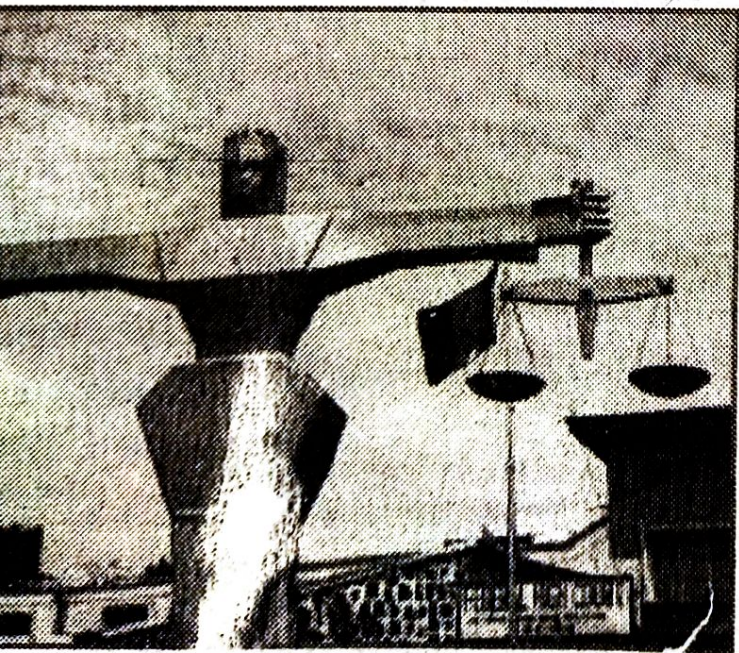
"We seek the cooperation of the members of the public to volunteer credible information that will crack this instant case please," Odutola said.

But the defendant pleaded not guilty to the charge, prompting the prosecutor to pray to the judge for a trial date.

Ayodele further asked the court to remand her until the hearing and determination of the charge.
