Police Launch Investigation Into Death Of Corps Member In Ogun

As part of efforts to tackle insecurity in the state, the Niger State Police Command has rescued a 22-year-old abducted Local Government Area of the state. In a statement by the state's Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Wasiu Abiodun of Police, Niger State Command, CP Shawulu Ebenezer Danmamman, the police was able to rescue the abducted girl.

According to him, "the police received an information on Wednesday 21st February, 2024 at about 1030hours, that four businessmen of Bako-Mission village, Pissa District of Borgu LGA to drop a sum of three million naira within three days in the village, via Pissa District or be kidnapped.
