

Man Dead In Anambra Auto Accident – FRSC

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) has confirmed the death of a male passenger in a [collision](#) involving two vehicles in Anambra State.

Mr Adeoye Irelewuyi, Anambra FRSC Sector Commander who confirmed the incident on Tuesday disclosed that the driver lost control.

He added that the crash included a commercial driver identified as Mr Francis Basil driving a black Ford E-250 bus with registration AN 1234, is Good Logistics, and a driver of a Nissan Caravan commercial bus known as Augustine Orjiwuru with registration AN 5678.

“According to an eyewitness, the driver of the Ford vehicle was at speed when one of his front tyres pulled off, he lost control of the bus that was in front.

“A total of 11 people comprising of seven male adults and four female adults are involved in the crash.
