

Man 40, kills 70-year-old mother, alleges strange voice influenced him

The Akwa Ibom State Police Command has arrested one Inyangake James Peter, 40-years-old, for allegedly killing his biological mother, one Mma-Offiong James Peter, about 70-years-old at Ikpe Annang Village in Es-sien Udim LGA of the state.

The suspect, who allegedly committed the act penultimate week, has confessed to the crime and has been transferred to the State CID for discrete investigation according to a press release made available by the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), CSP Odiko Macdon.

The statement further reveals that, "The suspect on interrogation alleged that he had a voice saying "kill her", "kill her" and he decided to oblige.

Isaac of Ikot Obok Nsit in Nsit Ibom LGA who allegedly murdered his son, one Iboro Isaac, 18-years-old last year following a family misunderstanding, has been arrested.

"Cases of some family members killing their biological relations has been of great concern to the Command in recent times," the statement added.

"Also, on April 9, 2024, Anti-Robbery Squad of the Command
