

Police rescue 3 kidnap victims, neutralise 8 kidnappers, bandits in Bauchi

The Bauchi State Police Command in conjunction with Hunter's group have successfully rescued three kidnap victims and

neutralised eight suspected kidnappers and bandits.

In a press release by the Command's Public Relations' Officer (PPRO), SP Ahmed Wakil, said the operation was carried out on April 22, 2024, following credible information received by the Command

regarding suspicious activities near the state's border between Bauchi and Plateau states.

According to him, "The detectives deployed from Gumau, Tilde, and Tulu Divisions encountered armed bandits during their routine patrol and engaged in a gunfight in self-defence, resulting in the neutralisation of four (4) suspected kidnappers.

"Two of the suspects in the eleventh hour, who later died, confessed to multiple kidnapping incidents across Bauchi and Plateau states, including the heinous killing of a village head in Ruruwai village, Lame district, Toro LGA, Bauchi State, on March 17, 2024.
