

Gunmen kill security guard; abduct SAN's sister in Oyo

Some unknown gunmen on Thursday evening abducted Alhaja Seliat Raji,

an elder sister to Ahmed Raji, a Senior Advocate of Nigeria, in her house in Iseyin Town, Oyo State, killing her security guard in the process.

According to a source, the kidnappers arrived at

the residence of the woman on a motorcycle, and in an attempt to force their way in, shot and killed the security guard.

Upon gaining entry, Saturday Telegraph learnt that Seliat was abducted and

the kidnappers went away with her in her Lexus car.

When contacted for confirmation of the incident, the Public Relations Officer (PRO) of the Oyo State Police Command, Adewale Osifeso, said that the kid-

nap was true and that investigation had begun on the matter.

His words: "The kidnap information is true, and investigation is ongoing. Updates will be communicated, please," he said.

Saturday Telegraph learnt from a reliable source that the kidnappers have contacted the senior lawyer on the phone, but it was not confirmed if they had demanded for ransom or not.
