Praying man drowns in Lagos beach

he police said yesterday that divers were battling to recover the body of a 30-year-old man who allegedly got drowned at the Elegushi Beach, Lagos, where he had gone for prayers.

The Lagos State Police Command spokesperson, SP Benjamin Hundeyin, told the *News Agency*

of Nigeria (NAN) in Lagos.

He said that a report to the police indicated that the man, simply identified as Samuel, had gone to pray at the beach with his friends.

Hundeyin said that the case was reported to the Ilasan Police Division at about 7.20 a.m. on Tuesday by a man whose name

was not mentioned.

Hundeyin said that the man's report revealed that on Tuesday, at midnight, he and three of his friends left Igbesan in Ogun to Elegushi Beach, Lekki for prayers.

The image maker said that the report stated that during the prayer session, at about 4.00 a.m., one of the friends, named Samuel, 30, allegedly

got drowned.
