as hit-and-run driver kills woman in Ogun, injures another

hit-and-run driver has killed a female pedestrian along the Sagamu-Benin Expressway in Ogun State.

Our correspondent learnt that the driver, who was travelling from Ijebu-Ode, knocked down a male and a female pedestrian by the road side.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of the Ogun

State Police command, Omolola Odutola, who confirmed the incident to journalists in Abeokuta yesterday, said the incident occurred at 9:40p.m on Sunday, near Dalof Filling Station at the Sagamu area of the Sagamu-Benin Expressway.

"An unidentified vehicle from Ijebu-Ode direction towards Sagamu interchange hit a male and female pedestrian beside the expressway.

"Both victims suffered injuries and were taken to Live Well Hospital in Sagamu for

treatment.

"Unfortunately, the 22-yearold female pedestrian named, Elizabeth James, from Sagamu died at the hospital," Odutola said.

The police spokesperson added that the body was transferred to Fakoya mortuary in Sagamu.

"Police visited the accident scene with traffic authorities, collected evidence, and are currently investigating. Further updates will be provided," she said.
