

MNJTF: Troops Eliminate 140 Terrorists, Arrest 57 In Borno

Troops of the Multinational Joint Task Force (MNJTF), have killed 140 Islamic State of West Africa Province (ISWAP) insurgents and arrested 57 others in Marte Local Government Area of Borno State.

The Force Commander, Maj.-Gen. Ibrahim Ali, said this at a news conference in Maiduguri yesterday.

Ali said the feat was recorded sequel to series of air interdiction at Tumbun Fulani and other locations in continuation of decisive offensive aimed at clearing remnants of the insurgents hibernating shores of the Lake Chad.

He said: “Operation LAKE SANITY 2 air interdictions have been highly effective.

“These aerial operations conducted by national Air Forces from Chad, Nigeria and Cameroon have led to destruction of crucial terrorist logistic bases and staging areas.
