The evewitness said that the hoodlums opened fire on the vigi-(2) At Onyibo Junction, Nnobi the lance men and in the process shot down one Hon Eloka Onveiekwe. the commander and another unidentified person before veering

towards Onvibo Junction at Nnobi in a bid to escape.

hoodlums were said to have seen another group of security personnel blocking their way.

According to the witness, the bad guys waited at the transformer close to the iunction where they and the security officials exchanged fire and in the process shot persons including a child of about nine vears who was said to be going on an errand and two women, one of whom was said to be a newly married woman who was returning from the garden carrying a basket of bitter kola on her head.

The witness said there were no incidents at Nnobi Junction when the fleeing hoodlums got there, but they only fired shots to scare street traders from the road.

Police arrest 3, recover firearms, ammunition, motor batteries in Enugu

he Enugu State Police Command has arrested three suspected criminals and recovered firearms, ammunition and 15 motor batteries within Enugu metropolis.

The command's Spokesman, DSP Daniel Ndukwe, made the disclosure in a statement vesterday in Enugu.

Ndukwe said that police personnel serving in Emene Division, in concert with law-abiding

citizens recovered a Beretta pistol with 36 rounds of 0.9mm calibre ammunition on June 16, around 7 p.m.

Ndukwe said that the firearms and ammunition were recovered from a small bush where they had been abandoned around Airport Corner, by Old Abakaliki Road, Emene in Enugu.

"The exhibits were suspected to have been abandoned by criminal elements on the hot trail of the police operatives for allegations of armed robberies." he said.

The spokesman said that in another operation, three suspects were arrested by police personnel serving in the Awkunanaw Division in Enugu on June 7, around 2 p.m.
