

Obaseki Gives Edo CP 7 Days To Fish Out Who Who Raped, Killed U

The Edo State Government has given the Edo State Commissioner of Police, CP Funsho Adegboye seven days to fish out the perpetrator of the rape and murder of a 21-year-old University of Benin fresh graduate, Miss Adekolure Idowu Glory.

Glory was allegedly raped and killed in Iyowa Community, Benin City, on Thursday, June 13, 2024.

She was said to be on her way home from processing her clearance when she was tortured and raped to death. Her body remains were dropped close to her mother's house.

The Governor, in a statement released by the Edo State Commissioner for Communication and Orientation, Chibuike Umeh, over the incident, noting that an order has been given to the Edo State Commissioner of Police to fish out the perpetrator of the unconscionable act within the next 7 days.
