

# Truck Accident Kills Female Biker In Lagos

The Lagos State Traffic Management Authority (LASTMA), yesterday said a container bearing truck killed a female biker while descending a road in Lagos state.

It was learnt that the truck driver lost control of the vehicle while in motion and the truck fell on a female biker while descending a road in Lagos state.

LASTMA's Director, Public Affairs and Enlightenment Department, Adebayo Taofiq revealed this in a statement via the agency's official website.

The statement partly read, "Early this morning, operatives of the Lagos State Traffic Management Authority (LASTMA) discovered the body of a female biker trapped under a loaded containerised truck in Lagos.

"Preliminary investigations revealed that the truck driver, who was speeding, lost control and caused the truck to fall on the biker, who was riding a motorcycle. The driver, upon realising the severity of the accident."

The Special Adviser to Governor Babajide Sanwo-Olu on Transportation, Sola Giwa, confirmed that the incident occurred on Iganmu Bridge. "Immediately after the incident, LASTMA personnel called in other emergency responders including the LASERMA Response Team."

Giwa said the Lagos State Ambulance Service had taken away the deceased's body. At the same time, the containerised truck was being moved to clear the vehicular movement on Iganmu Bridge.

He also added that police officers have been deployed to ensure security during the rescue operation. The governor's aide also "warned truck drivers to adhere to speed limits both within and outside the state."
