

Man caught with female head in Ibadan community

A man, who identified himself as Musa Bello, was in the wee hours of Sunday arrested with a female head by some Vigilance operatives, at the Amuloko community in the Ona Ara Local Government Area of Ibadan, Oyo State.

According to residents of the Akinrimisa Zone 2 community, the suspect and another person who Musa named as Tunde, were walking within the community in the night when the Vigilance men saw them, and were asked what was in the cement bag that one of them was holding, they said there was nothing in it. Upon search, however, a decapitated head of a female was found wrapped in a cloth, concealed in a plastic bag and hidden in a cement bag.

A staff of Amotekun in the area, who plead-

ed anonymity, said the residents handed over the suspect to them, and he had been taken to the Amotekun Headquarters at Dandaru area of Mokola in Ibadan.

Boat Accident: 2 days recovers 3 more bodies
