

# Police nab Navy Seaman over alleged killing of ex-CNS' son

**T**he Federal Capital Territory (FCT) Police Command has arrested a naval personnel in connection with the murder of Aminu Ibrahim, son of former Chief of Naval Staff (CNS), Vice Admiral Ishaya Ibrahim.

According to the Commissioner of Police (CP), Benneth Igweh, the Seaman, Abdulrasheed Muhammed, who was a guard at the late CNS' residence

in Maitama, Abuja, made away with his alleged victim's Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV) after allegedly shooting him at close range.

He said in the course of investigation, it was discovered that the suspect belonged to a three-man armed robbery gang, adding that efforts were being intensified to round-up others on the run.

The CP said the suspect confessed to being a member of a three-man gang specialising in armed robbery and snatching luxury vehicles.

He said efforts were ongoing to apprehend the remaining gang members, and the suspects will be charged to court upon completion of investigations.

The Police Command said it also arrested twin brothers for alleged theft of an Automated Teller Machine (ATM) card in Abuja. CP Igweh said the suspects were arrested on Aug. 27 for allegedly executing a plan to swap ATM cards and withdraw money from unsuspecting victims' accounts.
