Zamfara: Group condemns killing of retired teacher, abduction of wife, others

The International Organisation for Human Rights Development and Environment (IOHRDE) Special Consultative Status with the Department

of Economic and Social Council, United Nations has strongly condemned the recent attack on the staff quarters of the Government Secondary School in Tsafe, Zamfara State, which led to the killing of Malam Kabiru and the abduction of three

women including his wife.

In a statement issued by President, Chairman Governing Board of the International Organisation For Human Rights Development and Environment, Akinyemi Ojo Adebayo, said this act of violence, committed by suspected bandits was a flagrant violation of human rights and an alarming indicator of the escalating insecurity in Nigeria.

According to it, reports indicated that, Kabiru was shot and killed after courageously resisting an attempt to be abducted by the assailants.
