Makama gathered that the troops, in a special operation conducted at Ngazalgana village in Gujba Local Government Area of Yobe State, made contact with terrorists and neutralised Malam Jidda, who was identified as the Ameer (leader) of Ngorgore and Malumti villages.

Items recovered in the aftermath of the encounter included AK-47 rifles, magazines, and a motorcycle used by the terrorists for mobility.

"In another operation on the Timbuktu Triangle axis, a snap ambush team deployed by troops engaged Islamic State of West Africa Province (ISWAP) elements in a swift and decisive encounter.
