The Nigerian Army has recorded decisive gains in its ongoing campaign against terrorism and other emerging security threats.

The operations resulted in the neutralisation of two terrorists, arrest of 11 suspects, voluntary surrender of two terrorist family members, and the

The troops of 8 Division Garrison deployed at Forward Operating Bases (FOB) in Tsamaye and Mai Lalle, Sabon Birni Local Government Area, in 5 neutralising two terrorists and compelling others to abandon their positions.

The troops recovered three AK-47 rifles and a motorcycle at the scene, further degrading the operational capacity of the fleeing insurgents.

The sustained operational tempo continues to yield results in the North East. Two relatives of terrorists, an adult female and a child, voluntarily s

Preliminary debriefing indicated they escaped from the CHURCHUR axis, underscoring the intensifying pressure being mounted on terrorist stro
