

1 dies, 9 injured on Lagos-Ibadan Expressway crash – FRSC

A road accident at New in Lagos.

Garage, inward La-
gos-Ibadan Expressway,
has led to the death of one
person, while nine others
sustained injuries of vary-
ing degrees.

The Public Education Officer, Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Route Commander Oluwadamilola Jayeola, disclosed this in a statement made available to journalists on Saturday

Jayeola said that the crash, which occurred at about 6:55 a.m., involved a white Iveco truck with registration number MEK 34 XC and a white Toyota commercial bus, ENU 814 XJ.

“Tragically, one male passenger lost his life, while
nine others — eight males
and one female — sustained
varying degrees of injury.
No passenger escaped un-

hurt.

“FRSC rescue team responded within minutes and evacuated the injured to the Emergency Centre, Ojota, and Gbagada General Hospital, while the deceased was deposited at Real Divine Hospital Mortuary, Ibafo.

“The obstruction was cleared swiftly, restoring normal traffic flow,” she said.
