

Police Nab Lady Over Alleged Killing of Husband in Delta

The Police Command in Delta State has arrested a woman over the alleged killing of her husband in Mosogar Community, Ethiope West Local Government Area of the state.

The spokesman of the command, DSP Bright EDAFE, disclosed this to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in a phone conversation yesterday in Warri. EDAFE said that the lady drew the testicles of her husband; she drew it, and you know that part is delicate.

"The man died in the process and the suspect has been arrested," EDAFE said. A reliable source, who did not want his name mentioned, said that an elder brother of the deceased reported the matter to the police, adding that the name of the deceased was Jakpor Efemini, adding that he was aged 32.

He added that the incident occurred on Tuesday at about 1:20 pm following a misunderstanding between them. "My younger brother's wife (name withheld) held and drew the testicles of her husband."

"In the process, my brother slumped and was rushed to the hospital where he was later certified dead. "The corpse has been deposited at a mortuary in Mosogar," the source quoted the deceased brother.

Meanwhile, the suspect who was reported to have escaped to an unknown destination after she allegedly committed the crime had been nabbed by the police and she is undergoing interrogation.
