IPMAN Member, Wife, Servants Slaughtered

n Aba-based executive and a member of the Independent Petroleum Marketers Association of Nigeria (IPMAN), Mr Christian Michael, was on Monday night slaughtered at his home along with his wife, brother, housemaid and house boy, by persons suspected to be hired assassins.

An eyewitness account Michael, who was the chief executive of both Essential Suits, Abuja, and Essential Oil, had his throat cut by the assassins with his mouth sealed with adhesive tape, while his hands were tied behind his back, and meted the same treatment to others.

A close associate of the murdered businessman described him as "a progressive young man in his early 30s, saying that his "slaughter confounded his friends, as no body could hazard a guess why assassins called on him and his family."

He said before the deaths, Michael had on Sunday night held a meeting with Ngwa IPMAN members in Aba, adding that it was not clear if he quarrelled with any person at the meeting to warrant such a gruesome attack.

Speaking on the incident, the state Commissioner of Police, Mr Samson Wudah, said the police has swung into action to unravel the mystery.

Wudah said the killing could
