Thirteen people, including the driver and a family returning from a family engagement in Kaduna died instantly.

Only the 's and e family (who is also a u. ...onal village head in Takur), survived the accident.

His two wives, four children after preliminary police and three relations perished in the gations

People in Dutse were downcast, when news of the accident

filtered in.

They lamented the sad loss and blamed the high rate of accidents on the Kano-Wudil-Gaya-Dutse road on sharp bends and

narrow roads.

They appealed to the Federal and state governments to stop the carnage by turning the road to a

dual-carriage way urgently.
