Militants Kill 3 in Port Harcourt

A boat conveying staff of Hyundai, a major contractor in the oil industry, was last night attacked by unknown gunmen, suspected to be militants, killing three in the process.

Among the dead include an unidentified expatriate, a military personnel, and another civilian believed to be a staff of the company. Six others in the boat, sustained gunshot wounds and were subsequently rushed to the Liquefied Natural Gas Company (LNG) Bonny clinic.

Confirming the report to THISDAY last night, the Rivers State Commissioner of Police, Mr. Felix Ogbaudu, said he is aware of the attack, but stated that only two people were killed by the unknown men. Details of the attack were sketchy last night.
