Tanker Crushes ASP, Family Members to Death

orrow, grief and despondency yesterday enveloped the rank and

file of the Nigeria Police Force (NPF), when an Assistant Supritendent of Police (ASP), attached to

Elere Division, Lagos, was crushed to death, alongside his wife and two children.

THISDAY gathered that the ASP, whose name was not disclosed, was said to have met his untimely death, when a fuel tanker lost its control and ran into ASP's vehicle, which was parked at a filling station, close to the famous China village, along Ojota, Lagos.

Eye witness account said the gory accident, which occured when the deceased policeman, unsuspecting of the fuel tanker, that it had lost control, apparently ran into it before falling on top of it, while he queued up in the filling station to buy fuel.

The incident, THISDAY gathered, also claimed six other vehicles, which ran into the fuel tanker.

It was also gathered that the the remains of deceased ASP and his family, whose identity were not made known as at the time of filling this report
