suddenly they opened fire. killing them instantly.

The check-points were mounted on the request of owners of two popular fast food joints in the area, but the incident scared customers away from the usually busy spots, with many taking to their heels. Sources said since the checkpoint was mounted, there has not been any report of robbery in the area for a very long time, an area which hitherto was a flashpoint, raising specula-

tion that it may be an act of vengeance.

According to an eve-witness, "it all happened in a flash, we suddenly heard gunshots and the next thing we saw were some people climbing down from a car and rushing at policemen who were already lying on the ground. They kicked at the bodies and shouted insults at them before taking their guns and escaping in the car."

Enugu State Police Public Relations Officer, Mr Mike Abattam, when contacted confirmed the incident, and said the hodies had been recovered and deposited in a mortuary, while a massive man-hunt had commenced.According to him, "we have alerted all units to hunt those hoodlum, and I can assure you we will get them in no distant time, they cannot escape."
