

# Undergraduate Stabbed to Death in Minna

A 400 level student of the Federal University of Technology (FUT), Minna, Ahmed Suleiman Daba, was recently stabbed to death by a former student, who was rusticated from the institution in 2005.

The sudden created confusion, which prompted other students who were at the party to scamper for safety. Ahmed Sule, as he is popularly called, according to eye witness, was however, unlucky, as the invaders went for him and stabbed him several times at his back while trying to escape
