Αn eye-witness account said trouble begun when plots of land belonging to five families were snatched by a clique who said land compensation levy should be paid by the owners.

to their According accounts, an alleged land committee, which was set up for that purpose by the village leadership tried to gain entrance into the fenced land, while its owners refused them entry, suspecting that the committee had already been compromised, which resulted in the machete fight

An unconfirmed report has it that though 15 persons were severely injured, one person may have died, due to injuries

sustained during the fight. However, it is not also clear whether the man feared dead is a member of the family that owns the land, but it was gathered that the man was at the centre of the fight, as he was said to have used his machete

Mrs Lilian Ozor, 56-years-old who lives int the area said, "we know those that own these land and we do not have any land committee. The problem is that some people are not happy that such large expanse of land is owned by the families, so two persons, Rt Reverend Jerry Dada Obi and Ikechukwu Ezenwankwo, Ikechukwu formed the committee that
