houses razed in Ini Local Government, Nsit Atai, Uyo, Ukanafun and Abak local government areas of the state.

Following this development, the state Governor, Godswill Akpabio is reportedly having a close door meeting withstakeholders in the affected local government areas of the state. Although the meetings were inconclusive. Akpabio pleaded

with them to allow peace to reign.

Meanwhile, gates of residence of Akpabio and that of thestate Chairman of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in the state, Mr Otu Ita Toyo, were locked against female Councilorship aspirants who protested the conduct of the primaries.

Dressed in black, the aspirants staged peaceful protests to register their dissatisfaction with the primaties.
