

THISDAY visited ljebu-lgbo yesterday, sporadic gunshots were heard.Also, properties worth several thousands of naira were vandalised, with policemen battling hard to bring the crisis under control.

Several calls to the State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr Femi Awoyale, including a text message sent by THISDAY to his mobile phone to confirm the incident were rebuffed.

However, an official of the council area who spoke to THISDAY pleading anonymity, confirmed that five persons were killed, adding that policemen in ljebu-lgbo did not respond to distress calls.
