

Tragedy as Teenager Dies in Building Demolition Job

It was a sad moment yesterday as a teenager employed as part of the workers demolishing a two-storey building in Enugu, apparently for a more befitting structure was killed in the process by a falling object. The teenager, who was until his death in junior secondary school and identified simply as "Ojukwu", was knocked down by a falling object thrown by other labourers who were upstairs working in the building. It was gathered that the labourers were unaware that the boy was in the direction where they had thrown the debris from the building. The falling object from the building located at No 3, Obiagu Road, Enugu had smashed the boy without recognition, leading to his instant death. The incident attracted members of the neighbourhood who gathered lamenting the sad incident. Our Correspondent, who visited the scene also saw other labourers crying uncontrollably over the death of Ojukwu who was said to have engaged in the part time job unknown to the parents.
