



Twin Sisters Found Dead at Business Centre

Decomposing bodies of teenage identical twin sisters have been discovered inside a business centre located at Independence Layout, Enugu.

The bodies, according to sources, were discovered on Monday morning when neighbours were attracted by the stench oozing out of the business centre.

The sisters, who according to sources, hail from Mgbagbuowa, Ezeagu Local Government Area, in Enugu, may have died of suffocation after inhaling carbon dioxide from a generating set.

One of the sisters, who works in the business centre, our source said, invited her sister for an overnight job on Saturday evening, which the owner wanted on Monday morning.

Although the cause of the death was not clear, our source added that the girls took the generating set inside the business centre for safety, and may have been suffocated from carbon dioxide emission from the generator.

Neighbours forced the door of the business centre open and discovered the bodies and invited the Police who took the corpses to the mortuary. When contacted, Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Mike Abatam, said he was on tour of police locations in the state, and would react after he had been briefed.
