

# Edo Assembly: Ex-Majority Leader Killed over Land Dispute

Former Majority leader of the Edo State House of Assembly and now Secretary to the Esan South-East Local Government Council of Edo State, Hon. David Aimiebenomon, has been allegedly killed in Ewohimi, his community, by a palace chief over a land dispute. Late Hon. Aimiebenomon who was the majority leader of the Edo State House of Assembly during the third republic was allegedly murdered last Sunday while leaving the palace of the Enogie of Ewohimi where he had gone to testify in a land dispute between the his alleged killer and another family . The suspected killer was said to have hit the late scribe who was on a motorbike with his car before escaping from the scene to avert a mob action .
