Said Haruna: "I didn't know Kebbi State and I have not been to Birnin-Kebbi, but my boy, who claimed to know Birnin-Kebbi, misled me and I was on high speed when I suddenly saw a bend and the vehicle lost control."

A medical officer, Bello Modibo, in charge of surgical ward at the hospital said the injured victims were responding to treatment and will be discharged soon.

As at the time of filing this report, the vehicle was still at the scene of the accident surrounded by road

safety officials.
