## Six Dead, 10 Wounded as Farmers, Herdsmen Clash in Adamawa

Adamawa State Police Command has confirmed the death

of about 6 persons including a two year old baby girl and 10 others hospitalized with serious injuries in Tigno-waduku area of Lamurde Local Government council, following a clash between some Fulani herdsmen and the villagers. The command spokeswoman, Altine Daniels (ASP), said in a press briefing on wednesday that the villagers were attacked by the wondering herdsmen at about 3.00am on Tuesday morning after a quarrel earlier in the day over an alleged destruction of a farmland by the cattle of the nomads who were passing through the village with their cattle. She said that although normalcy had been restored to the area, the police would continue to monitor the situation, as farmers and herdsmen clashes was rampant in the state, at this period of the year. She appealed to the people to report any unusual movement of the herdsmen said to be migrating from neighboring Republic of Cameroons.
