Serial Killers on the Prowl in Delta

No fewer than $\,$ five persons have been reported murdered in cold blood in various parts of Delta State.

They include two women and a boy who went to farm in Onicha Ugbo, Aniocha North Council of the state and another boy who lost his life because of N120 in Adeji, Okpe Council.

Reports from Onicha Ugbo said that four suspects are being interrogated by the police in Asaba in connection with the incidents.

50 year old Mrs. Maria Nwani Odiogor and her son Ifeanyi who went to fetch firewood on December 12 last year were allegedly murdered.

A 37 year old man, Mr. Luke Nwanze who was allegedly seen by some persons in the community to be in possession of

a blood stained cutlass on his way from the farm that faithful day was arrested by the police.

Also, a 73-year old man, Pa Ndubuisi Ikenna and two others were earlier arrested following the murder of a 49 year old Stella Ikenwa who was found dead at Onicha Ugbo with machete cuts on her body while harvesting cassava in one of the suspect's farms.

THISDAY gathered that farmers especially women in the community and its environs are now afraid to visit their farms following the spate of killings in parts of Delta North

Over five women were allegedly murdered in their various farms in Ibusa, Oshimili North Council late last year. However the Onicha Ugbo Development Union has expressed sadness over the ugly incident, urging security operatives not to leave any stone unturned in their investigations.

In another development, one Samson Amereroro, 23 year old was last weekend murdered at Adeje, Okpe Council. The deceased, a panel beater was said to be sharing the sum of N120 gotten from snooker game with four others and in the process, fight broke out.

It was alleged that Samson slumped following a major injury he received but later died at the Central Hospital, Warri. Three suspects are now in police net in connection with the incident.

Similarly one Joseph Mudiaga Osodi, 15 year old boy of Mammy Market three, Effurun, Uvwie Local Council was stabbed on the head last week by another boy.

Details of what led to the action were not immediately known but the police confirmed that the victim who was rushed to General Hospital, Agbarho near Warri later died.

Police Public Relation Officer in the state, ASP Charles Muka while confirming the report on Wednesday condemned the high incidence of murder, saying that all the suspects would soon appear in court after thorough investigations.


