

2 Soldiers, Others Killed as Youths Ambush Soldiers

It was a bloody day in Okolobri, a community near Yenagoa, Bayelsa State, yesterday when some armed youths engaged the men of the Joint Military Task Force (JTF) known as Operation Restore Hope in a gun battle that left two soldiers and five of the militant warriors dead.

Although it could not be ascertained what led to the clash, **THISDAY** gathered that the people who engaged the soldiers in the battle were cultic worshippers of the Ijaw deity known as Egbesu and were allegedly on a procession along the road leading to Okolobri when they were confronted by soldiers who queried their possession of sophisticated weapons which they openly displayed.

The action of the soldiers was said to have incensed the

boys as the situation soon degenerated into a fierce battle.

In the ensuing battle, two soldiers and five of the cultists were killed while several persons from both sides sustained several degrees of gunshot wounds.

Most of the cultists were said to have escaped into the surrounding forest even as the corpse of the five killed were taken to the headquarters of the State Police Command at about 5.30 pm by the men of the Joint Task Force with two Hilux jeeps and one armoured carrier vehicle.

It was gathered that one of the deputies to late militant leader from Odi Community,

Ken Neweigha, was among the dead.

But it was not clear whether the leader of the group, King Blue, was among the casualties.

Ekiti Gets First ISO
