

### 3 Feared Killed in Intra-NURTW Clash in Oyo

Three people, one of them, a youth corps member serving in Oyo state were feared dead in intra-union clash between supporters of Lateef Akinsola Tokyo and Lateef Salako Eleweomo in the battle for the control of the controversial National Union of Road Transport Workers (NURTW) in Oyo state. The corps member, it was alleged, was killed when he emerged from a popular eatery at Iwo road in Ibadan when the skirmish had subsided. He was reportedly hit by a stray bullet and died before he got medical attention. Another person identified as Jellli Alabi, was reportedly attacked by unidentified gunmen in Egbeda area of Ibadan and was shot from a moving vehicle during the clash. The third person was killed in the early hours of yesterday. Tokyo confirmed the news of the latest casualty to reporters yesterday in Ibadan at a news conference to update the public on the next line of action following the ban on the activities of the union by the state government.
