The team of the mobile police officers shot dead the victim, while another occupant sustained very serious gun shot injuries in a moving vehicle when the driver refused to stop over the police alleged incessant demand for money from him.

Dele who bullet pierced through both sides of his head at the back seat, and the other victim identified as Waheed, were occupants inside a truck owned by Mount Olive Nigeria Limited, a commodity company with head office in Baboko area of Ilorin.

But the Command's Spokesman, Dabo Ezekiel in a statement yesterday tacitly denied that the team of the mobile police officers were extorting money as claimed by the villagers.
