The gunmen numbering about three, according to a witness, arrived on a motorcycle at around 10pm where they forced themselves into the relaxation joint and immediately began to shoot sporadically in the air.

The witness added that the gunmen identified the two victims and fired several bullets on them until they died instantly. The two victims were identified as Muhammad Adamu and Ibrahim Baba both residents of Bunde quarters in Akko local government area of the state

Another witness Mr. Patrick Emmanuel who spoke to newsmen described the situation as shocking adding that, although he manage to ran away the gunshots greatly terrified everyone at the joint.

The Police Public Relation Officer (PPRO) Asp Ahmad K. Mohammed confirmed the incident to newsmen and said those shot by the gunmen were suspected to be their primary target saying the police have already commenced investigation on the issue.

Our correspondent gathered that as soon as the gunmen were satisfied with the death of the two victims they immediately fled the scene on their motorcycles without stealing anything from the hotel


