15 Killed, 10 Injured in Jos

The restive town of Barkin Ladi, an outskirt of Jos, the Plateau State capital, was again thrown into a mourning mood yesterday morning as a vehicle conveying maize to a local market in the area rammed into a group of youths, killing 15 of them on the spot and injuring 10 others, who are now in critical conditions. THISDAY gathered that the youths were members of Boys and Girls Brigade from three churches in Barkin Ladi: Church of Christ in Nations (COCIN), Assembly of God Church and Baptist Church. The youths, who were about 40 in number, and between the ages of 12 to 16 years, were said to be on a routine jogging exercise when a Peugeot 505 wagon conveying fresh maize skidded off the road at Tundun Maza, and rammed into them killing 15 of them on the spot. It was also gathered that immediately the incident occurred, the driver and the owner of the maize being conveyed from Bokkos to Bukuru market jumped out of the vehicle and fled into the nearby bush.
