

## Gunmen Attack Bauchi Village, Kill Six, Injure Two

Six persons were vesterday feared killed and two others injured when gunmen attacked Gambiri village in Ganjuwa Local Government Area of Bauchi State.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr. Hassan Auyo, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP), who confirmed this, said preliminary investigations showed that the attackers were cattle rustlers.

"Our preliminary investigations show that the attackers were cattle rustlers," he said.

The Director of Danga Vigilante outfit in Bauchi, Alhaji Yusuf Hassan, whose member was killed in the attack, said they were alerted by some villagers that Gambiri village was being acked.

of I get in (NAN), he said by the time his men got to the vilage, the attackers had fled.

"We received information that some gunmen attacked Gambiri village in Ganjuwa Local Government Area.

"Our men were dispatched to the area, but on reaching the place, they found out that the assailants had left.

"While conveying the dead and injured to the hospital, my men were ambushed and one of them was shot dead," he said.

Hassan pledged that the incident would not deter the commitment of the outfit in its fight against crime and criminality in the state, and assured the people that the attackers would be brought to book.

He said those who lost their lives in the attack had been buried according to Islamic rites, while the injured were admitted at Abubakar Tafawa Balewa Teaching Hospital (ATBTH), Bauchi.
