## Four Die in Nasarawa Auto-crash

The Nasarawa State Command of the Federal Road Safety Corps has confirmed the death of four persons in an Auto-crash along Akwanga-Lafia Road. The state sector commandant of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Ms. Feustina Alagbe, confirmed the accident to journalists yesterday in Lafia, adding that it occurred at about 2 p.m. and the corpses were deposited at the Ola Hospital, Akwanga. According to her, "the victims were rushed to Ola Hospital in Akwanga Local Government Area of the state, but on getting to the hospital four people were confirmed dead by authorities of the medical outfit and the corpses deposited in the same hospital." Alagbe continued that the accident involved two buses; one Sharon bus and a J5 bus while 12 persons were involved in the road mishap. Findings revealed that a former Special Assistant to Governor Umaru Al-Makura of Nasarawa State on Media and Publicity, Ahmed Tukur, was also involved in the accident and currently responding to treatment at the Federal Medical Centre, Keffi.
