

last Wednesday also, five people were killed in the attack in Kizachi community, Kauru LGA. Zangon Kataf and Kauru LGAs had been under 24 curfew since June 11, 2020.

The protesting women, most of who were dressed in black while others were half naked, condemned the killings and wanton destructions of their property by the invaders as well as the failure of the state and the federal governments to stop the killings.

The women also wept profusely over the killings, as they marched to the palace of the Agwam Atyap (the traditional ruler of Atyap people) to expressed their anger over the massacres.

The women lamented that their communities were no longer safe as herdsmen continued to unleashed mayhem on them without being apprehended by security agencies.

According to them, "Our communities are under siege by herdsmen and our government is not doing anything to protect us.

"Our husbands, children and relations are being slaughtered like rams on a daily basis, and this government is just watching. Our lives don't matter to this government.

"We can't go to our farms, we can't go to the markets, and we are not safe even in our homes. So where do we run?"

The women lamented that they have become refugees in their land, saying many of the villagers were moving to IDP camps for safety.
