Bus Drivers Protest Killing of Colleague by Suspected 'Yahoo Boy'

popularly called 'Yahoo Boys'.

Social and economic activities were yesterday disrupted in Ibusa, a town near Asaba in Delta State, as commercial bus and taxi drivers took to the streets to protest the gruesome killing of one of their members by a young vehicle owner suspected to be an advance fee fraudster

The suspect was alleged to have willfully sent the bus driver to his early death by running his car over him whilst he knelt down to beg him for scratching his car with his bus.

THISDAY learnt that some relations of the deceased, who hailed from Kwale in Ndokwa West Local Government Area of


the state, had taken the corpse of the driver and dumped it in the house of the suspected killer in Ibusa, after the incident last Monday.

According to the protesters, the driver had last Monday afternoon scratched the car of the suspect with his commercial bus shortly

after loading in Asaba and heading to Ibusa in Oshimili North Local Government Area.

The suspected 'Yahoo boy'

was said to have descended on the driver, beating him up severely despite the fact that the driver pleaded with him that it was a mistake.
