

Suspected Armed Robbers Kill Two Guards in Ondo

Gunmen suspected to be armed robbers have killed two private security guards working at a filling station located at Customs' Junction, Ondo road, Akure, the Ondo State capital.

This is coming as three persons were said to have lost their lives

yesterday in an auto crash that occurred at Liyetu Village on Ondo-Akure Highway.

The lifeless bodies of the two guards, were said to have been discovered within the Lube Bay area of the popular filling station, named AA Rano by other workers, when they resumed for work yesterday.

The filling station was one of the most patronised station by motorists in the axis.

One of the victims of the robbers, was identified as as a 45 -year-old Israel while the second guard started working at the filling station, just two days before the incident.

A supervisor at the station,

Mr. Buhari Ashiru sad Israel and his colleague were found drenched in their pool of blood around 5:30am yesterday morning.

Ashiru explained that one of the security men who was 28 years old, had just spent two days at the filling station.
