

Pastor's Killing: Kano CAN Petitions Ganduje, Demands Arrest, Prosecution of Perpetrators

Following the recent killing of Pastor Shuaibu Yohanna by some irate youths of Masu community in Sumaila Local Government Area of Kano State, the state chapter of the Christian Association of Nigeria (CAN) has petitioned Governor Abdullahi Ganduje, calling for the immediate arrest and prosecution of perpetrators of the dastardly act.

The petition was also copied to the state Commissioner of Police, the Director of Department of State Services (DSS) and the Kano State Attorney General and Commissioner for Justice.

This was contained in a

statement signed by the CAN Chairman, Rev. Samuel Adeyemo and issued yesterday.

"The prelude to the event leading to this dastardly and inhuman act was the family feud that occurred between a young man called Sabo who eventually killed his brother with a pistol on Monday, 20th September, 2021.

"The said young man, Sabo who is an inconsistent member of the late Pastor Shuaibu Yohanna's Church, reported and surrendered himself to the Nigeria Police Force without an arrest.

"So, we demand immediate arrest and investigation of perpetrators of this dastardly and inhuman act of culpable
