One Killed, Many Injured as PMS, Federal Boys Clash in Ibadan

A member of the Oyo State Park Management System (PMS), Afiz Agate, was yesterday shot dead in a dash between the group and the Federal Boys, while several others were injured in the clash that lasted for several hours.

While details of the clash were yet to be known, it was learnt

that security personnel alongside Southwest Security Network, codenamed Amotekun, had taken over the area to ensure peace and orderliness.

It was however gathered that the crisis started on Thursday evening at Oremeji Agugu area of the ancient city of Ibadan.

The Public Relations Officer (PRO) of PMS in the state, Alhaji

Emiola Jelili, who confirmed the clash, said the Federal Boys are not drivers but area boys who extort motorists in the Oremeji area.

He said, "There was no fight among us. What happened is that there are area boys called Federal Boys, they are not drivers but they extort drivers. We have reported them to the police at Agugu Police Station but nothing has been done about it. Someone told us that the police could not do anything to them because some of the policemen connived with them.

"But yesterday, while the robbery at Iwo Road was going on, there was gridlock on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway and these Federal Boys used that also to rob people in the traffic.
