

Driver Killed, Others Injured as Container Falls on Vehicles in Lagos

A driver was killed and several others injured after a truck laden with two 20-foot containers fell on three vehicles at Cele bus-stop end of Oshodi/Apapa expressway, Lagos yesterday.

The deceased, who was

driving a commercial bus with late number AKD 489 XZ, died before help could come.

The multiple auto crash involved a Mack truck, a Volkswagen bus with registration number AKD 489XZ, a highlander Jeep with registration number AGL 366FP and a Toyota

RAV4 with registration number AAA 353FH.

Although there were different accounts as to how the tragedy struck, eyewitness account alleged that the driver of the commercial bus was driving against traffic when he collided with the truck that was coming

from the opposite direction.

But another account alleged that the truck, which was heading inward Mile Two, had a brake failure and in attempt to use the median as wedge, reportedly rammed into the commercial bus, trapping the driver on the spot.
